Class 1 Prelim 7 (14 and under) Class 2 Prelim 7 (Open) Class 3 Intro A Junior lead rein Class 4 Intro A Junior Assisted Class 5 Intro A Junior Non assisted Class 6 Intro A Open

All dressage tests can be called. In the assisted section you can enter the arena and stand in the middle and give instruction but you may not touch the pony or children or walk/run with them.









Combinations competing in classes 7 & 8 may not complete in the Mini SJ Classes








Rosettes – 1st-6th Commencing 10am Advance Entry Fee: £10 or £8 LHPC per class. Entries will be taken on the day for an additional £2 per class unless the class is full.

Class 12 Poles on the ground Class 13 Cross poles Class 14 30cm Lead Rein or Assisted Class 15 40cm Lead Rein and Assisted or Unassisted Class 16 40cm Ride & Run Unassisted

Lead: any pony / rider with someone running in front or by the side with or without a rope.Assisted: a person standing in the middle to give instruction, any touching of pony / rider will result in combination being classed as lead.

All classes may be split if numbers permit and at the judges discretion.

Novice = pony and rider combination not to have been placed 1st or 2nd on 2 occasions at that height or higher.







Rosettes – 1st-6th Commencing 10.30am Advance Entry Fee: £12 or £10 LHPC per class. Entries will be taken on the day for an additional £2 per class unless the class is full.

Class 17 Introduction to working hunter: 40cms.

Come and have a go at a working hunter (WH) class. An encouraging class designed for combinations new to WH, never to have been placed 1st-3rd in any working hunter class. May be lead.

Class 18 Nursery Stakes maximum 50cms. Riders 12 years and under. Ponies any height.

Class 19 Novice Working Hunter. Fences maximum 60cms. Horse and Rider combination not to have been placed 1st -3rd in any working hunter class. Horses and Ponies any height.

Class 20 Open Working Hunter. Fences 70-80cms. Horses and Ponies any height. Working Hunter Championship for those placed 1st and 2nd in any working hunter class. A trophy will be awarded to the highest placed LHPC member which may not be the winner. Sash to the Champion and Reserve.

FOLLOWING THESE CLASSES, THE WORKING HUNTER COURSE MAY BE OPEN FOR CLEAR ROUND, SUBJECT TO TIME. Entry Fee £5.00. Enter with Secretary. All riders to be 16 years and under as at 1st January 2024.







Rosettes – 1st-6th Commencing 10am Advance Entry Fee: £10 or £8 LHPC per class. Entries will be taken on the day for an additional £2 per class unless the class is full.

Class 21 Best Turned Out Horse / Pony and Rider. Not to be judged on conformation.

Class 22 Introduction to showing. A friendly, encouraging class for riders not to have been placed 1st - 3rd in any showing competition.

Class 23 Most suitable Lead Rein Pony. Rider 8 years and Under

Class 24 Mountain and Moorland. Ridden and In Hand. Class may be split depending on entries.

Class 25 Best Pony Club Pony / Horse - judged on performance and way of going not conformation. Competitors will be expected to jump a small jump during the show.

Class 26 Best ridden Coloured Pony / Horse. Any age.

Class 27 Best Veteran. Ridden or In Hand. Class may be split depending on numbers. Horses & ponies over age 16. Age to be displayed on bridle please.

Class 28 – Fancy Dress £5 entry in advance

Showing Championships: those placed 1st or 2nd in classes 21-27 will compete in the Championship. Sashes for Champion and Reserve.







Entry Fee : £3 per race or £10 per group.
Commencing at 1pm
Group A RIDERS 5 & UNDER – LEADING REIN ONLY
Group B RIDERS 8 & UNDER – MAY BE SPLIT INTO ASSISTED & UNASSISTED.
Group C RIDERS 12 & UNDER – MAY BE SPLIT INTO ASSISTED & UNASSISTED.
Each group will contain 4 races.
Enter with secretary.

Anyone 9yr and over

must be off the leading rein and for those that need assistance, their assistant should not make them go faster and the competitor must attempt the manoeuver.

Group D OPEN Each group will contain 5 races - The races may include Bending, Ride & Run, Mug Race, Sack Race, Walk Trot & Canter (canter for groups C & D), Monte Carlo.

A numbered course of show jumps and cross-country fences in an enclosed area. BODY PROTECTORS MUST BE WORN AND NO FIXED PEAKS ON RIDING HATS DUE TO XC FENCES.

A fun class with obstacles, small jumps and timed section. Rosettes to all clear rounds. Commencing at 10 am ENTRY ON THE DAY - PLEASE GO TO THE SECRETARY TENT

Entry Fee £5 per round

CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHY (LHPC Members Only)

The Championship Trophy will be awarded to the pony/ horse and rider combination to have accumulated the highest number of points during the day in both Jumping and Showing (championship classes are excluded). The aim being to encourage and reward all round ability. Competitors must have won points in at least one class in various rings No Horse/pony to compete in more than 3 jumping classes plus a working hunter class. You may compete in more than one working hunter class but this will reduce your available jumping classes.

Points will be awarded as follows:

1st Place 6 Points

2nd Place 5 Points

3rd Place 4 Points

4th Place 3 Points

5th Place 2 Points

6th Place 1 Point

In the event of equality of points a decision will be made based on the number of 1st or other highest placings.

N.B. This is a Challenge Trophy for LHPC members, which is due to be returned in time for next year's show.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1 The Judges decision is final.

2 All classes to be run under Pony Club Rules.

3 Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers, nor any person acting on their behalf accepts any liability for any loss damage accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all the Officials and Stewards.

4 Hats to current PAS-015 standard and MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN MOUNTED. Pony Club Members must have pink hats tagged with current and official Pony Club tag prior to the event.

5 Ages as at 1st January 2024.

6 All children competing in the showing and working hunter rings must have attained their 3rd birthday by the 1st January 2024.

7 2018 Body Protectors & skull caps must be worn for the cross-country clear round. 8 In ridden showing and working hunter classes, if a rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony / horse and rider must leave the ring, dismounted, and take no further part.

9 Horses and Ponies must be 4 years old and over.

10 No spurs or whips longer than 30" must be used in showing and working hunter classes. All whips must be padded batons and used on the whole of the showground.11 The committee will not be responsible for any loss or injury to any person, property or animal however caused.

12 Insurance. Please ensure that you have adequate and appropriate insurance for horse, rider and property.

13 PHOTOGRAPHS: by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst competing; these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed please tell the photographer on entering the arena, before you jump.

14 Any objections must be handed to the secretary in writing within 30 minutes of the incident together with a deposit of \pounds 10 which will be returned if the objection is sustained.

15 No cantering allowed around showground, warming up should take place in the appropriate area. No lunging anywhere on the showground

16 Refunds will only be given on receipt of a valid veterinary/doctor's certificate.

17 The committee reserves the right to cancel or alter any classes.

18 No horse/pony to jump in more than three jumping classes and one working hunter class.

19 The organisers reserve the right to alter / amalgamate / cancel classes without prior notice.

20 Participants attend at their own risk; neither the Committee nor Ledbury Hunt Pony Club will be liable for any loss, damage or accident to horses, riders, property, or other persons.
